JOB DESCRIPTION

GENERAL POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Performs routine and extensive grounds keeping and building maintenance duties on all Tribal buildings and facilities.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assist other departments as requested, including moving furniture and storing supplies.
 2. Repairs, replaces and installs plumbing fixture and appliance in compliance with local building codes.
 3. Sprays lawn, shrubs and trees with fertilizer, herbicides and insecticides.
 4. Repairs and installs fences, gates, walls and walks.
 5. Makes minor repairs on equipment such as lawn mower, spreader, etc.
 6. Cuts lawn using hand, power or riding mower; trims and edges around walks, flower beds, walls, etc.
 7. Plants grass, flowers, trees and shrubs; prunes shrubs and trees to shape and improve growth.
 8. Removes snow and ice from building walkways and steps; may rake leaves, clean and sweep litter.
 9. May perform minor repairs and maintenance procedures on equipment utilized in grounds keeping.
 10. May perform routine laboring and maintenance duties when grounds keeping work has been completed.
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QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High School Diploma or GED preferred.
2. Must have a valid CA Driver's License and be insurable through the Tribe's insurance carrier.
3. Must successfully complete a pre-employment drug/alcohol and background screen.
4. Must be willing to work a flexible schedule including weekends. Hours will be scheduled to accommodate community events.
5. Must be able to lift a minimum of 50 pounds.
6. Must be able to work well under little or no supervision.
7. Must be able to follow detailed oral or written instructions.

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KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

1. Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondences and memos.
 2. Ability to write simple correspondence.
 3. Ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations to other employees of the organization.
 4. Ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions and decimals.
 5. Ability to compute rate, ratio and percent and to interpret miscellaneous drawings and schematics.
 6. Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but involved written or oral instructions.
 7. Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations.
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WORKING CONDITIONS

Position requires prolonged standing, walking, reaching, twisting, turning, kneeling, bending, squatting and stooping in the performance of daily activities. Requires good manual dexterity (hand, hand with arm, two hands) and multi-limb coordination movement. Must be able to lift, push, pull or carry objects, use abdominal and lower back muscles to provide support over time without fatigue and to effectively jump, sprint or throw an object. Acute hearing is required. Regularly works near moving mechanical parts and in outside conditions that include inclement weather, heat and humidity, and exposure to dust and asphalt. Frequently must be able to lift up to 30 pounds, normally must be able to lift up to 50 pounds, and occasionally must be able to lift over 50 pounds. Noise level is generally loud. This job also requires the use of a vehicle, and an employee must be able to have those repetitive motions and coordination associated with operating a motor vehicle.
